Italian Sparkling

Ferrari Brut, Trentino \$50
100% Chardonnay. "We're going to make you an offer you can't refuse on this sparkling wine of pronounced finesse." Perfect served as an aperitif or with lighter dishes, especially seafood. Clean and balanced, with a slight and pleasant finish of ripe fruit and a hint of bread crust. Cent Anni!!!

Rose Wine

Planeta Rose, Sicily \$34
100% Syrah. Silky, crisp, balanced and refreshing, finishing off dry. This wine is the answer for hot summer days and all seafood selections. "Keep your friends close, but your Rose closer."

White Wine

Planeta Le Segrata Bianco, Sicily \$32
Luca Brasi sleeps with the fishes; speaking of seafood this one is where you want to be. Fresh, supple and round on the palate, with good balance between fruit flavors and crisp acidity.

Red Wine

Planeta Le Segrata Rosso, Sicily \$32
Prodromently Nero d'Avola. Vibrant fruit flavors are nicely balanced by ripe strawberry and coffee notes coupled with soft tannins and a refreshing acidity. Leave the gun, take the cannolis!!!

Badiola, "Baby Super Tuscan", Tuscany \$36
This Sangiovese/Merlot Blend; Soft and smooth on the palate, with flavors of wild blackberries and raspberries; well balanced, with great depth and a long finish. With this wine you become a made man.

Bertani Secco Valpolicella, "Baby Amarone" Verona..... \$40
Secco-Bertani has been in continuous production for over 150 years and is rightly extolled as the "grandfather" of ripasso-technique Veronese wines – this wine is exquisite! A Godfather favorite!

Travaglini Gattinara "Baby Barolo" Piedmont \$64
Full-bodied, with intense flavors of cherry, raspberry and spice culminating in a long and smooth finish. 100% Nebbiolo. This interestingly shaped bottle was a favorite of the Pope in 1951. Ti Saluto Don Corleone!
